Dear Custodian of Records:

Pursuant to the Ohio Open Records Law, I write on behalf of the Federation for American Immigration Reform (FAIR), Washington, DC and request the following records from the Springfield Police Division:

1. All reports alleging abuse or eating of cats, dogs, ducks or geese from and including March 1, 2024 through and including September 12, 2024.
2. All recorded 911 calls alleging abuse or eating of cats, dogs, ducks or geese from and including March 1, 2024 through and including September 12, 2024.
3. All recorded body-worn camera footage from any incident involving allegations of abuse or eating of cats, dogs, ducks or geese from and including March 1, 2024 through and including September 12, 2024.

The Immigration Reform Law Institute (IRLI), where I am Investigations Counsel, as well as FAIR, which IRLI represents as its client and which is the requester, are both nonprofit organizations established under the laws of the District of Columbia and tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. As such, both FAIR and IRLI are “persons” entitled to make such a request. *See Oh. Rev. Code §§ 149.43 et seq.*

IRLI on behalf of FAIR further requests all fees be waived because this request is in the public interest, primarily benefits the general public and does not serve a commercial purpose. If the total fees will exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), please notify me via this email address.
